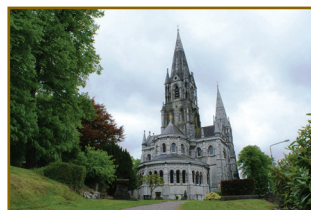


Resources & Facilities

The Characteristic Spirit of our School

The School is a community where all pupils are equally valued and respected - irrespective of gender, social background, family circumstances, educational achievement, physical characteristics or intellectual functioning. Pupils experience a sense of caring and belonging, they are treated fairly and their spiritual, moral and religious development is encouraged, as is their intellectual, social and academic development. The work of the School is conducted in an atmosphere of tolerance and respect for religious differences. The admission policy of the School permits those of other traditions to become pupils.

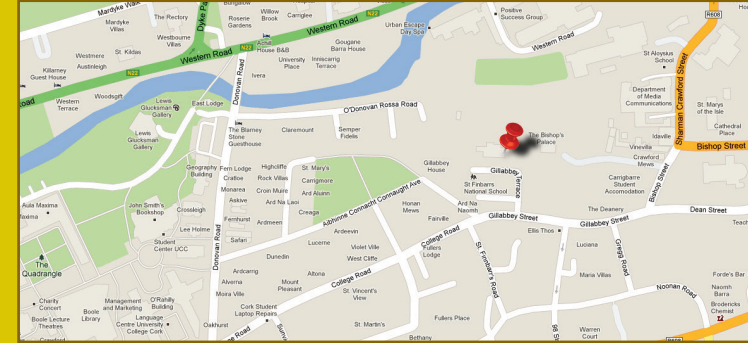
